Microsoft HoloLens is a mixed reality headset with transparent lenses that gives users an augmented reality experience. One of the system's great advantages is that it enables users to experience 3D holographic images as though they are part of their physical environment. You can, for instance, pick up a virtual cup of coffee and place it on the real table in front of you.

Experiments in three areas

Strukton Rail has been experimenting with HoloLens technology in three areas:

- Training employees in their own working environment. Training time can be shortened by up to 50% and as training takes place in a safe and familiar environment, more employees can be expected to successfully complete courses first time around
- Enabling remote troubleshooting. Experts no longer need to travel to a location but can access it virtually and provide workers on site with detailed instructions
- Improving multidisciplinary collaboration in BIM models. Viewing a design on location together ensures everyone is on the same page and helps to detect any major issues earlier on in the process
